

Event Terms and Conditions

By registering for a Water Research Australia (WaterRA) event, you agree to accept the following Terms and Conditions.

Registration

Registration fees are in Australian dollars and are inclusive of GST. Member rates apply to all employees of Member Organisations. All registrations will be confirmed with an email notification and receipt from WaterRA. WaterRA reserves the right to allocate up to 80% of event registrations to WaterRA member registrations for all events open to both members and non-members.

Payment

Payment can be made online at the time of registration, or an invoice can be requested. All payments must be received in full by WaterRA prior to the commencement of the event unless otherwise specified. If full payment is not received by this time, you may be denied access to the event.

Registration Cancellations and Refunds

Changes to the Event

WaterRA reserves the right at any time to change the format, content, speakers, location and timing or any other aspect of the Event.

Event Postponement / Cancellation

WaterRA reserves the right at any time to postpone or cancel the Event and will not be liable to the attendee for any damages, costs, losses or expenses of any kind incurred or suffered as a result. If the Event is cancelled or postponed by WaterRA, attendees will be notified in writing and will be refunded the full registration fee.

Refusal of Entry

We reserve the right to refuse entry for all events if you are unable to demonstrate proof of registration. If permitted entry, you will be charged the full cost of the event (where charges are applicable).

We reserve the right to refuse entry to intoxicated registrants.

We reserve the right to refuse entry to registrants who are unwell.

We reserve the right to cancel registrations if registrants are not suited to attend an event based on the event availability. In this case, a full refund of the registration fee will be issued.
